






Oceania

Carriage on the road = waka on the


ocean

Going Green: Set

•The basic set will be a triangular modular stage. (rectangular pictured)



Set: Cont.

- •Cost- 500 1000 depending on materials
- •Instead of production and then subsequent destruction, these platforms can be used, reused, and then reformed into new shapes.
- Stackable for storage and height differences in individual designs.

Lights

•Following a strict shutdown procedure will allow the theatre to save on needless energy

cost.



Sound

•Instead of using sound effects and the electronic systems, we choose to use foley artists instead of powering sound equipment.



Costumes

- •Due to the chosen location of the show, we will strive to use as many natural/recyclable materials in costumes as possible.
- Laundered clothes will be hung up to dry
- Recyclable/post-consumer materials
