Found Object Color Wheel
Due Tuesday January 24, 2017

Objectives:

To be aware of the colors surrounding you every day

To find smooth transitions between primary, secondary, and tertiary colors, while paying attention to variation in hue and tint

Description:

You will create a color wheel made from found objects. You must be able to securely attach the objects to a piece of white foam core that is 12"x12". Please avoid objects that might rot, degrade, or attract bugs. Each color example must be at least 75% the color you are representing.

Materials: White foam core, found objects

Procedure: You will collect found objects and assemble them into a 12 color, color wheel. (Draw a circle inside the square with black marker and then divide the circle into 12 "pie" slices) Don't attach the objects to poster board with tape; use glue, wire, etc.... You may not "color" in with pencil or paint any of the colors, and only one of the 12 colors may be represented by paper.
