Please create a multi-media/creative collage for the characters from *The Trojan Women* listed below. Each collage should be on its own 11"x14" white Bristol board. If you wish to have a different format (Size, paper choice, color) you must speak to me and have it approved prior to presenting the project. The collages should accurately portray color choices and patterns, and, if you wish, have an emotive conceptual element. The collages as a whole can be approached with various collaging methods, but should hold together as a cohesive design and a set of costume plates that all go together, starting with, the figures should all be the same size. Each collage should be labeled with both the title of the play and the character. Please be as detailed as is possible in this medium (this will not be the same as a PP presentation)

Oral Presentation:

Outline:

Create a detailed outline of your presentation that includes main points, specific wording you want to use, etc... It is not a written out speech, you want to be able to be spontaneous and not memorized, and you definitely do not want to read directly from your presentation. This outline is the support to your presentation and will demonstrate that you have planned and then practiced what you will say about your work. In order to have an effective oral presentation, you will need to be prepared (have practiced) and organized (have notes/an outline).

The oral presentation will be graded based on the provided rubric.

Costume Plot and Piece Lists:

Updated and final versions of *both* documents, based on feedback from peers and myself. In collaging it can be difficult to portray all the details, so please make sure your piece lists are very detailed. (These documents will be turned in on BB Learn)

Self and Peer Critique:

There will be a brief critique of each project by the presenter and the class. Comments should be kept succinct, pertinent, and be more than "I like the project." Or "I could have done so much better." Why is the project good, what is, and is not working, etc... The presenter will have time for a one to two sentence self-critique, and I will call on students to respond to each project.
